The keynote speaker was Judi Holler, author of *Fear is My Homeboy*. Judi challenged the group to make waves, live out loud and take action in our lives. Finance Update

Annual dues remain the same for the next year. Dues are \$35 for standard membership (with reduced rates of \$30 for 50-year members and \$25 for recent graduates). In addition, we have levels of membership support. Members paying \$50 will be at the Carnation level, members paying \$75 will be at the Lyre level, and members paying \$100 will be at the Hera level. These levels include membership dues. The additional monies paid go to support scholarship/grants, collegiate relations, programming and other MuMu expenses. Members will be recognized for their generosity in the membership directory. In 2021-2022, we had 126 dues paying members (45 Standard, 29 Classic, 1 New Graduates, 28 Carnation, 4 Lyre, and 19 Hera)

Donations from MuMu funds for the 2021-2022 membership year were as follows:

These donations were made possible through the local alumni donations to MuMu. Our annual Rose Brooks Silence the Violence event which was held in the fall of 2022 raised \$20,020.53. Also, this year we voted to help the victims of violence seen at Research Medical Center by providing undergarments. A total of \$248.70 was used to purchase undergarments.
